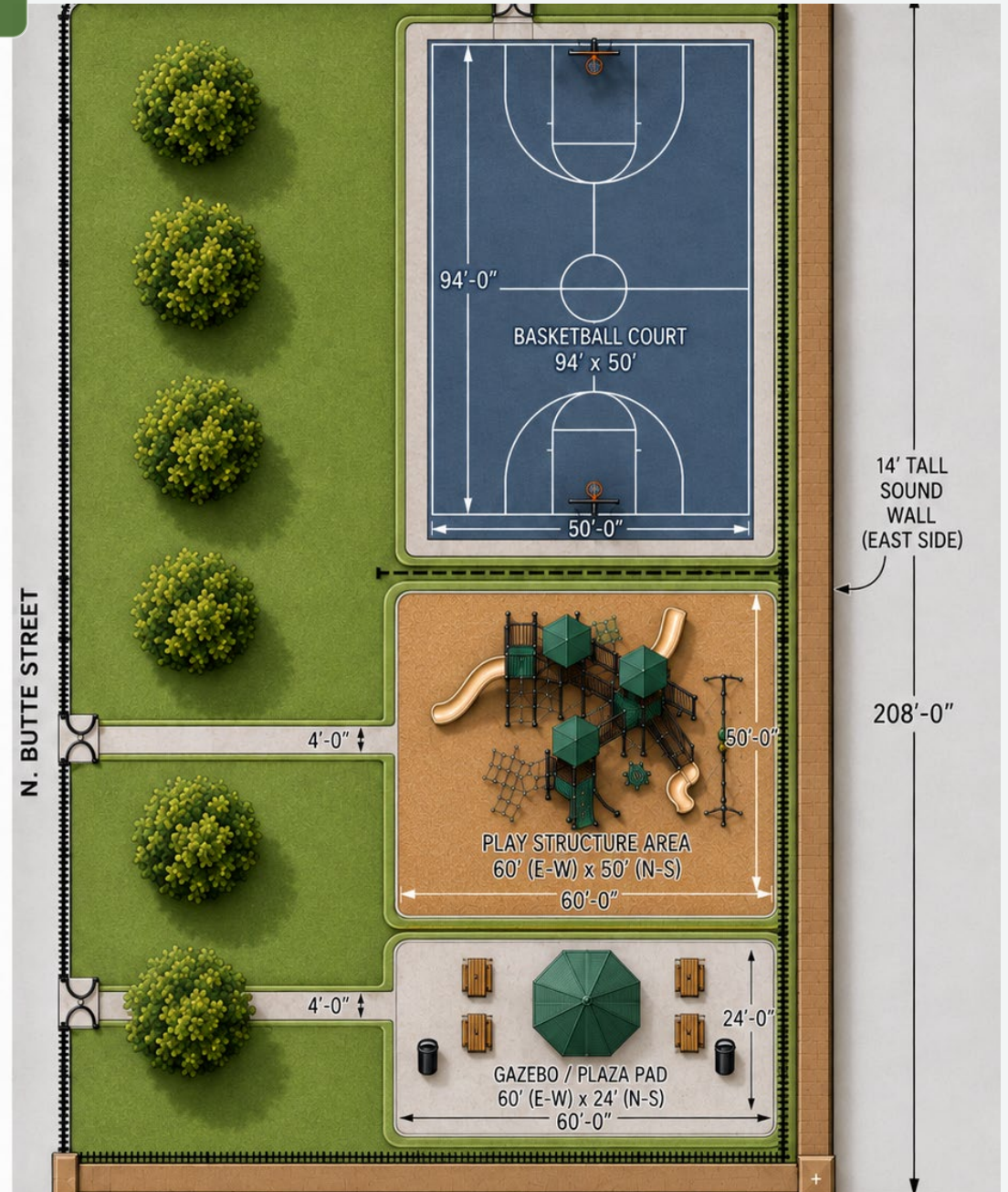




What Can the Grant Fund?

Eligible Project Types

Create a new park, renovate an existing park, or expand an existing park.

Recreation Features

Examples include basketball courts, playgrounds, picnic/BBQ areas, gazebos, cornhole and other active or passive recreation.

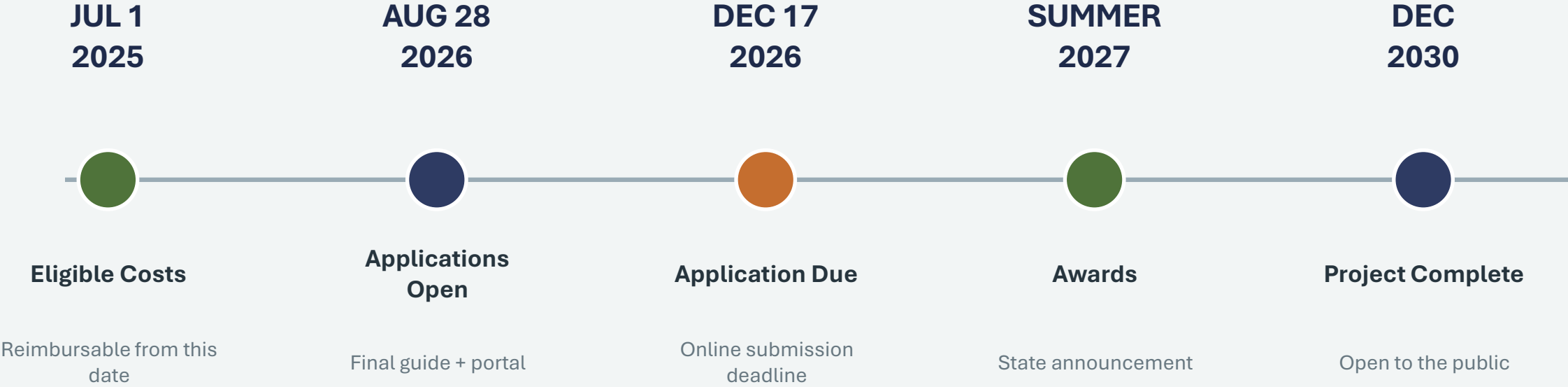
Support Amenities

Paths, landscaping, lighting, perimeter fencing, parking, restrooms and other amenities that support recreation.

At least one recreation feature must be created or renovated.

Grant performance period ends June 30, 2031 • 30-year operation & maintenance obligation through June 30, 2055

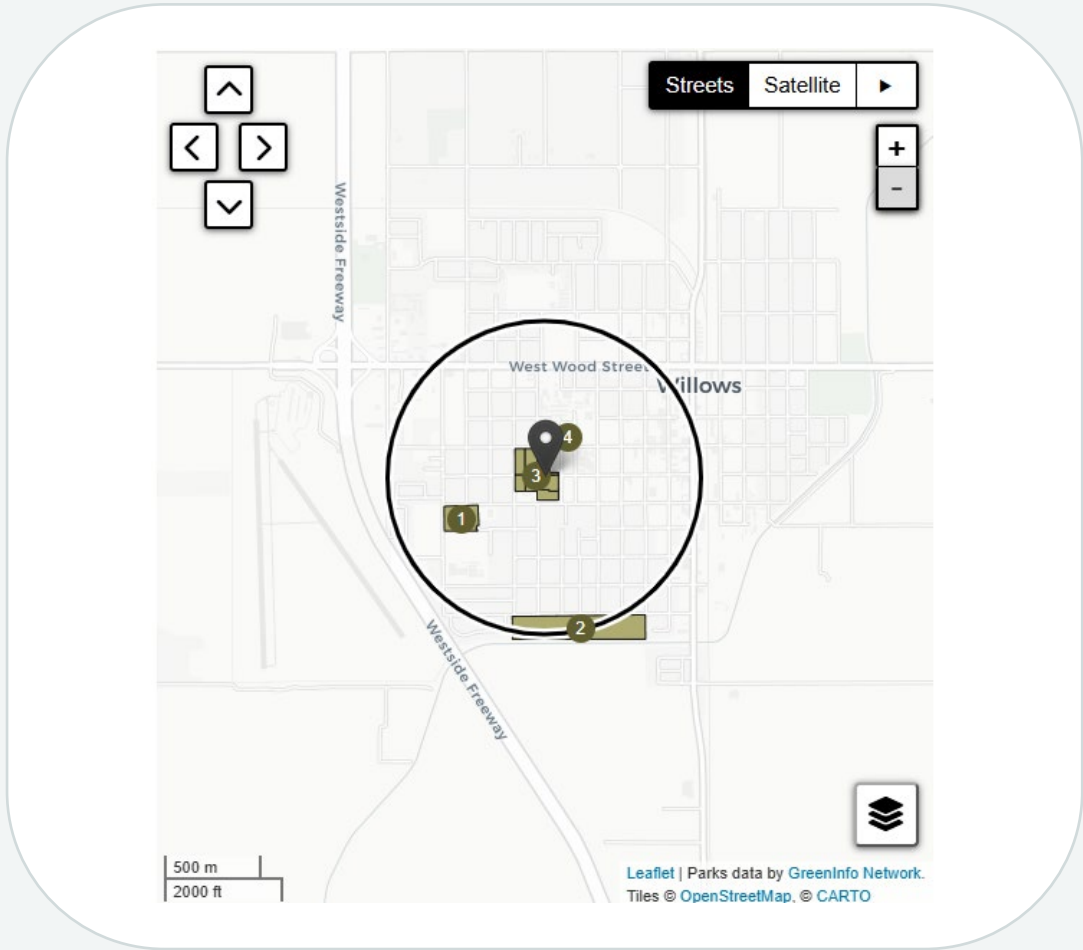

Eligible Projects: Why a New Park?

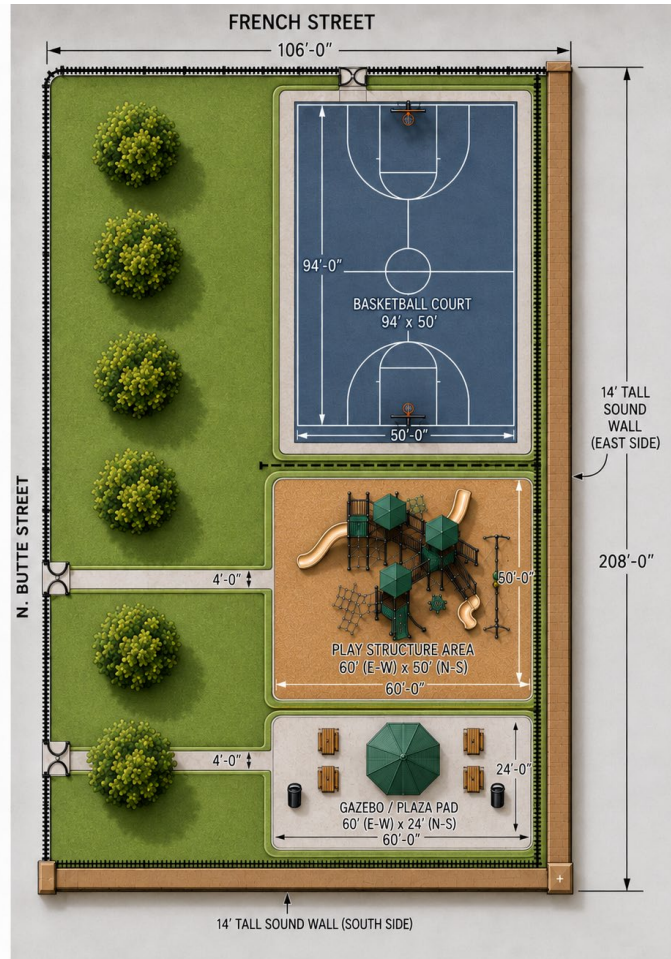


26.5 ACRES

of existing park space within the mapped 1/2-mile radius

- **4 parks already fall inside the radius**
Central Park 5.5 ac • Jensen Park 9.0 ac
Sycamore Park 11.2 ac • Memorial Park 0.74 ac
- Disadvantaged / severely disadvantaged communities are present
- 3 high-ranking climate vulnerabilities: heat, drought & flooding

NEW PARK = HIGHEST “TYPE OF PROJECT” SCORE



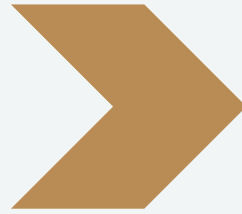

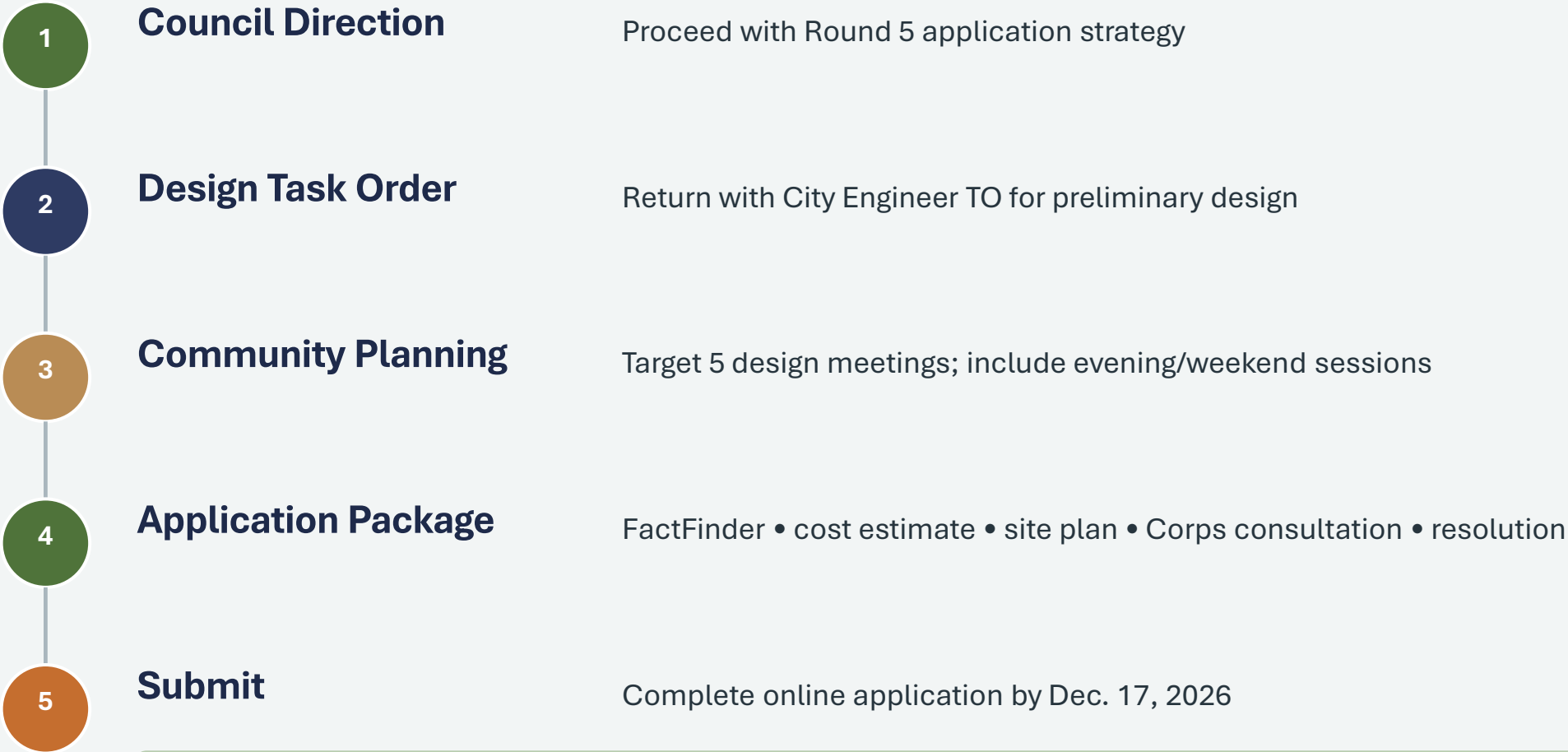


Proposed Use

- City Engineer preliminary design
- Concept plan refinement & dimensions
- Preliminary cost estimate
- Grant application technical support

Goal: develop enough design and cost certainty to submit a competitive application by December 17.
